HOLY WEEK AND EASTER CONCERNS

PREPARATION OF PALMS: Following Holy Communion and Breakfast on Saturday of Lazarus on April 15, all the GOYANS of our Church should remain to fashion the palm buds into crosses.

NEED ITEMS: LAUREL, ORCHIDS AND ROSE PETALS - Anyone who may have any laurel bay branches to donate please bring to Church on Saturday morning. Also, anyone who will have any white calla lilies in good condition for Good Friday and Easter please let Father James know so that he does not order them. If anyone grows lavender orchids, please bring them on Good Friday.

DYEING OF EGGS: The Easter eggs will be dyed on Holy Tuesday, April 18, beginning at 10:30 A.M. in our Fellowship Hall kitchen. All ladies are welcome to come and help.

HOLY UNCTION: There will be two services of Holy Unction on Holy Wednesday, April 19. The afternoon service (3:30 P.M.) is primarily for children too young to be present at the evening service which is scheduled for 7:00 P.M.

HOLY COMMUNION: Opportunities for reception of Holy Communion during Holy Week are many. One may receive on Holy Wednesday, Holy Thursday and Holy Saturday morning (See Holy Week Program) as well as at the conclusion of the Easter Sunday Liturgy. No communion will be given outside of the Liturgy. Holy Thursday's Liturgy, begins at 6:30 A.M. and ends approximately one hour later.

HOLY CONFESSION: Holy Confession may be heard by Father James by appointment. No Confessions will be heard during Holy Week.

OFFERING ENVELOPES FOR GOOD FRIDAY AND EASTER: With this year's Easter message of the pastor, you will receive the Holy Week and Easter Program, plus a Good Friday and Easter offering envelope. We hope you will be as generous as possible. You can bring the envelopes with you or otherwise you may mail them.

HOLY WEEK AND EASTER FLOWERS: Please offer your donations for the Epitafio and Easter flowers by using the envelopes we have mailed. We thank you very much for your gifts.

DECORATION OF THE EPITAFIO: All ladies of the parish are welcome to come and decorate the Epitafio (the Lord's Tomb). Some of the preparatory work must be done on **Holy Thursday**, beginning at 10:30 A.M. The decoration will be done following the service of the

Royal Hours on Great Friday, which ends at 10:00 A.M. The Epitafio must be completed by 2:30 P.M.

ALTAR BOYS FOR HOLY WEEK AND EASTER:

A list of Altar Boys for Holy Week will be mailed to each young man. Please plan to be present as assigned. If you cannot be present, notify Father James or the Church office far enough in advance so that a replacement may be found.

HOLY COMMUNION FOR SICK AND SHUT-INS:

Please inform our Church office of any sick and shut-ins so that the priests may make the necessary arrangements to go and give Holy Communion. Let us not forget our sick and infirmed.

EPITAFIO PROCESSION: The Epitafio (Lord's Tomb) which we decorate with beautiful flowers is of great significance to us Orthodox. The outdoor procession on Holy Friday evening is a reenactment of the Lord's burial. It is a funeral procession and we must act accordingly. We must follow behind the procession in an orderly, quiet and dignified manner. Even simple conversation should be avoided.

Also, unless our health demands, we are not to stay inside the Church, nor should we move ahead of the procession. At four stations we will pause to offer petitions for the living and the dead. The last petition will take place at the front entrance of our Church. After the petitions are concluded, the faithful will pass under the Epitafio, re-enter the Church and remain in Church until the conclusion of the service, at which time everyone should respectfully and quietly file by to receive the flower from the priest's hand. Please do keep in mind that these flowers are not to be discarded but should be placed next to your home icons. Upon drying, you may burn them together with the previous year's palms.

RECEIVING THE PASCHAL LIGHT: The rite of the lighting of the Easter candle and passing it on to each other is a most moving experience in the liturgical life of our Church. Since order in Church is paramount, we request that only the members of the Parish Council come up to receive the light from the priest. Then in an orderly fashion, they will pass it on to all the worshipers. Please cooperate!
